URGE provides tools, training and leadership opportunities to young people aged 15-30 to mobilize for reproductive information and services and win real victories for their campuses and communities!

**Canvassing Managers:**

URGE: Unite for Reproductive & Gender Equity seeks committed people in Bowling Green and Toledo who are passionate about reproductive/social justice to help implement our voter engagement campaign. As a canvassing manager for URGE, you'll get an inside understanding of the fight to attain reproductive justice locally in your community, as well as an opportunity to hone your professional skills in a fast-paced environment. URGE canvassing manager will work on their local campus and in their community with the Ohio State Organizer and Local Senior Organizer.

Candidates must have knowledge of and commitment to reproductive health and rights and/or social justice issues. This position will report to the Ohio State Organizer.

**Responsibilities**

- Attend a canvassing technical training and canvassing management/organizers training in February
- Complete door-to-door canvassing and phonebanking in order to register new voters, identify new supporters of URGE's work and to get out the vote
- Complete campus outreach, including but not limited to, classroom announcements, tabling, and student organization announcements
- Complete phonebanking to get out the vote and educate local voters
- Answer questions, provide support, and manage canvassers while on-shift and report feedback to organizers
- Foster relationships with current and new individual activists identified through field campaign in order to mobilize and build power

- Work with Ohio State Organizer to develop organizing skills in the one of the following areas: relationships with elected officials, coalition building, or event planning
- Attend weekly staff meetings with other managers of the Voter Engagement Team. Meetings will be scheduled so all staff are able to attend.

**Qualifications:**

- Strong oral communication skills on the phone and in person with local voters and community members
- Basic skills with technology in order to submit information about canvassing
- Able to walk for long periods of time, breaks are provided as needed
- Reliable transportation and valid drivers license preferred but not required
- Ability to work respectfully with people from diverse backgrounds
- Ability to commit to part time work during the campaign
- Previous experience in canvassing or organizing is required
- Managing experience is preferred, but not required
- A passion for reproductive justice and social justice issues
- A commitment to youth activism
- Active member of an URGE chapter or affiliate, and/or associated with a reproductive justice organization is preferred, but not required
- Ability to juggle multiple tasks with attention to detail
- Ability to work well with a team, take direction and feedback, and share skills and knowledge, and have a positive attitude

**Placement:** Toledo or Bowling Green

**Duration:** This position is temporary, and starts in late February and ends in early May, with the possibility of employment in the summer/fall or promotion depending on performance and funding.

**Salary:** This position is paid \$12.50/hr.
