

URGENT ACTION: PROTECT YOUNG IMMIGRANTS

Demand that Congress act quickly to make DACA permanent and include a pathway to citizenship.

DACA is Reproductive Justice

- ★ Reproductive justice cannot be achieved when people do not have the tools and agency to decide if, when, and how to parent.
- ★ Undocumented young people are less likely to seek reproductive care due to fear of deportation. DACA's deportation protection eliminates this barrier to reproductive care.
- ★ DACA keeps families together and sets young people up for economic success, allowing them to pursue work or educational opportunities and support their families.

Why is DACA under attack?

- ★ Ending DACA continues the administration's tireless crusade against the immigrant community. This time with a direct attack on young people who have never known a home other than the United States.
- ★ On September 5, 2017, the Trump administration announced they will be terminating the DACA program, effective in six months. The government will no longer accept new DACA applications.

Wait, remind me, what is DACA?

- ★ Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) (created in 2012) grants two-year protection from deportation to undocumented young people who were brought to the US as children and allows them to apply for a work permit.
- ★ These young people must meet stringent requirements to qualify. Once approved, they receive a Social Security Number and authorization to work, but the program does <u>not</u> include a pathway to citizenship or legal resident status.

Demand that your members of Congress pass a <u>clean</u> Dream Act (S. 1615/H.R. 3440) to codify DACA and include a path to citizenship!
